By ord^r and direction from Capt William Markham Depty Govern^r and Com^{rs} for setting out lands to Purchasers and Planters in Penn^a. Baring date ye 6th of ye 7th mo. 1682 Directed to me I hereby certifie into the ~~the~~ Proprietary and Govern^rs Secretaryes office yt I have caused to be surveyed and set out ye 27th of ye 8th mo. 1684 unto Richard ffews Purchaser, a certain peece or p^rcell of land lying and in ye County of Chester. Beginning at a corn^r marked red oak standing by Upland Creek from thence up ye seaverall Courses of ye said Creek to a Corn^r marked Poplar tree from thence alonge ye seaverall courses of a small runn to a corn^r marked poplar tree from thence N. E. b E. by a line of marked trees 340 perches to a corn^r marked white oak standing by Preslers Creek from thence along ye seaverall courses of ye said Creek to a Corn^r marked red oak from thence S. W. b W. by a line (b^y) marked trees 255 perches to ye first mentioned Corn^r red oak Containing two hundred twenty seven acres of land and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia this 29th of ye 5th mo. 1684.
