or cause to be survey'd unto him ye above sd number of Acres in ye Place above  
mentioned where not taken up already according to ye method of townships appointed  
by me, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office Given at Philadelphia  
ye 19<sup>th</sup> of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo. 1683.
