At ye request of William Frarrington, yt I would grant him to take up in ye
bank of ye front of Delaware answering his lott of forty two foot, for
conveniency of wharfing, & building storehouses. These are to will & re-
quire thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said feet
on ye bank & so far into ye street as ye Survey^r shall see meet, or ye place
will admitt of running out into ye River no farther y^e two hundred & fifty
foot, he building ye same according to Regulation and make returns there-
of into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 2^d 6th 1770. 1684.
