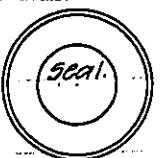

Upon request of Sarah Fuller Purchaser, yt I would grant her to take up in part Three hundred acres on Perrybeck Creek near to Jos. Ashton. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto her ye said number of acres in ye Place provided it be not already taken up according to ye method of townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof in (obl) my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 10<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1682.
