At ye request of Francis Fincher in right of Alexander Birdsley, Purchaser of five hundred acres, yt I would grant him to take up his Proportion of land wthin ye Liberties of ye City. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ten^{or} acres of land joyning to himself on ye north side wth ye front proportionable to his former, according to ye number of acres, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 26th 9^{br} 1683.
