By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> bearing date the 5<sup>th</sup> of ye 8<sup>th</sup> month last (directed to me) I hereby certify into his Secretary's office that I have caused to be surveyed and set out unto Erack Flower Purchaser, his front Lott at Delaware River the 12<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo. in the City of Philadelphia w<sup>ch</sup> said Lott is situated between \_\_\_\_\_ formerly called Dock Street on the south, and Walnut Street formerly called Pool Street on the north containing in breadth thirty foot and in length from ye front street to ye swamp on ye north side of ye 3<sup>d</sup> lott one hundred forty eight foot, and from the west side of ye 3<sup>d</sup> swamp to ye second street from Delaware, sixty four foot, on the south part of ye 3<sup>d</sup> Lott from the 3<sup>d</sup> second street to ye swamp seventy five foot, and from the east part of ye 3<sup>d</sup> Swamp to ye front street one hundred thirty five foot, bounded northward w<sup>th</sup> a vacant Lott westward w<sup>th</sup> the 3<sup>d</sup> second street, southward w<sup>th</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ Lott eastward with Delaware front street. And is accordingly entered and recorded in my office Philadelphia this 28<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> month 1684.
