whitte oke standing by the branch in the fork of the sd branch and runing  
 A long the Branch on sevarall courses to a marked betch tree standing by the  
 branch side from thence N. E by a line marked 160 perches to a marked  
Betch stand by a branch side and from thence a long the Branch and  
severall courses downe to the first marked whitte oke.
