yt I would grant him to take it up between Crumb creek & Darbey creek in y^e
County of Chester: These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause
to be surveyd unto him y^e sd number of acres in y^e afore mentioned County
at or near y^e place desired provided it be not already taken up, according
to y^e method of townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof
into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia y^e 21st 9br. 1683.
