 here by Enter this as a Caviet in ye Surveyor Generalls Office
 against any further procedance of them by taking out any retur-
 nes Concerning ye hereby Canceled premisses, untill we have
 a full and fair herienq before ye Councillor Com^{rs}. who are to
 Judge and ~~decide~~ determin ye Same.
