



Surveyed This Tract of Land to Joseph Burson in Right of and by order of Casper Wister. By Vertue of an order from Jacob Taylor to me directed. bering dat-the 3 of July 1731. Begining at a post in Gorge Rewits Line. then North one hounded pearches to a black oak. then West fourty fower pearches to a smal-spanish oak. then North by a branch caled Soxkcunk-one hounded and fower pearches to a smal-Ash. then East one hounded Seventy two pearches to a post by vacand Land. then South one hounded Sixty fower pearches to another post by Vacand Land. then West one hounded twenty Eight pearches by Vacand Land to the place of begining. Containing One hounded and fifty acres of Land. Surveyed the 6 day of the 6 month caled Augest with usal allowance for Highways in the year 1731.
