These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the sd Susannah Brandt the said eighty Acres of Land within the said Liberties according to the first Lines and true Bounds of Survey and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd thee certified by the secret<sup>y</sup> who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 18<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>mo</sup> 1701.
