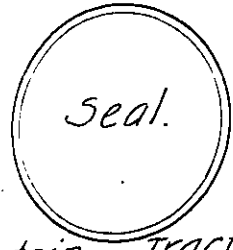

Where as Adam Birch having for some years been settled on a certain Tract of Land above the Mannor of Gilberts on Skuykill lying on both sides of Mingo Run. Without any Regular Grant or Title made to him for the same, hath requested us that we would Grant him a Sufficient quantity in the sd place for a convenient settle^{mt} Upon which It is agreed wth the Said Adam That there shall be laid out to him five hundred Acres in y^e place aforesaid fronting on sd River Skuykill the full breadth throughout that his ~~present~~ Improvem^{nt} now are, that is. from the hither fence of his ~~present~~ Rye field to y^e upper fence of his Wheat field & no further and by that breadth extending backwards till it shall take in the quantity aforesaid, for which he hath agreed to pay to the Prop^{rs} Use twenty pounds in y^e first Month 1705 with one Years Interest and twenty pounds in y^e first Moth 1706 with 2 years Interest. and 30^{lbs} in the first Month 1707 with 3 years Interest. completing 70^{lbs} y^e full consideration for the same together with y^e Quittrent of one shill. @ 100 Acres from y^e Year 1700 inclusive, These are therefore to Authorize and Require thee to survey and lay out to the sd Adam Birch the said quantity of five hundred Acres under the Bounds and Limits above described & make Returns into the general Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. W^{ch} Survey in case y^e sd Adam fulfill y^e Agreem^{nt} aforesd shall be valid, otherwise shall be void and of no other effect than as if the same had never been made nor this Warr^t ever Granted.
