By vertue of a warrant from ye Proprietary & Govern^r bearing date the 26th of the 12th M^o 1682, (directed to me) I hereby Certify into his Secretary's Office, that I have caused to be Surveyed and set out unto Jn^o Barnes of Bristol his Lott in the City of Philadelphia the 28th of ye Said Month. Containing in breadth fifty one foot and in length three hundred foot. bounded Northward wth Chesnut Street formerly called Wynne's Street, Eastward wth the Second Street from Delaware. Southward wth Wallobl^y Martin's Lott. Westward wth a vacant Lott. and is accordingly Entered and Recorded in my office Philadelphia this 29th of the 3^d Month 1684.
