

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 22^d of the tenth month 1701. to layout unto John Ball twenty acres of land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia in Right of three thousand acres of land Originally purchased of the Proprietary by Lewis David who granted one thousand acres thereof to Henry Lewis. who conveyed his Right to twenty acres of Liberty land appurtenant to the said Purchase to the said John Ball.

There was Survey'd the 26th day of the 3^d month 1702 unto the said John Ball twenty acres of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia Beginning at a Red oak at a Corner of John Thomas land. Then North by Vacant land forty perches to a black oak. Then East eighty perches to a post by Harford Road. Then South forty perches to a post in the line of John Thomas his Land. Then by the said line west Eighty perches to the Place of Beginning.
