By Vertue of a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of property and the Seal of the Province bearing Date the 29 of 10^{br} 1701. to Survey and Lay out unto Samuel Buckley of Philadelphia fifteen Acres of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia ten acres in Right and as part of his and his brother Thomas, Their first purchase of 500 Acres, and five acres in Right ^{of} 250 acres purchased of Richard Davies of Denbigh purchaser of the said Quantity.

There was Laid out unto Ann Buckley widow of the said Sam^l the said Quantity of Liberty land (on ye 24th of ye 1st mo. 1703.) Scituate on the west side of Schuylk^{il}—and bounded according to this ~~Draught~~ Draught.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of August 1909.
