At ye Request of Nathaniel Brunson, Purchaser of One Thousand and Two hundred & fifty Acres, y^t I would grant him to take up his Lotts in ye City both in Front & high Street, proportionable These are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or cause to be survey'd unto him his Lotts where they fell. he fencing y^m in & building upon ye front, according to Regulation, & make returns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 13th of ye 4th mo 1684.
