At the Request of John Barnes That I would Grant him a Resurvey on a Certain Tract of Land Scituate in the County of Philadelphia, laid out to him by Virtue of a Warrt. from my self ~~bearing~~ for 242 Acres in Right of his Purchase of 500 Acres. These are to require thee to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the sd Tract of two hundred forty and two Acres according to the first Bounds and Lines of Survey. And make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and seal at Philadelphia the third day of the Second Month 1701.
