At the Request of William Branson, Son of Nathan (obl.) Branson  
 of ye County of Berks  
 Purchaser of Twelve hundred and fifty Acres of Land in this Pr-  
 ovince in the Year 1683. That we would grant him to take up five  
 hundred and fifty Acres of the sd Land. the whole being con-  
 vey'd unto him the sd William by his said Father. These are to Auth-  
 orize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the sd Wil-  
 liam Branson according to the Method of Townships Appointed the  
 said quantity of five hundred and fifty Acres of Land in this Pro-  
 vince that is vacant & not enclosed nor seated by the Indians. And  
 make Returns there of into the Secretaries Office. Given under  
 our hands & Seal of the Said Province at Philadelphia the  
 fifteenth day of October in the Seventh Year of the Reign of  
 Queen Anne of Great Britain. &c Annoq Dom. 1708.
