



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the fifth Day of May 1719. Surveyed and Laid out for John Budd and Humphrey Morrey A Certain Tract of land Scituate on a branch of Perquamie - near Limbrick Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a Beach Tree Standing in line of limbrick Town. Thence by ye Same S. East Three hundred and Twenty pe^aches to A ^{North East} hickery Tree marked for a Corner. Thence by Vac^t land Three hundred Thirty & Seven perches to a white oak marked for a Corner. Thence by Vac^t Land N. West One hundred & Thirteen pe^aches to a Stake put for a Corner in the line of Hans Michel Herregers Land. Thence by the Same S. West one hundred & Ten perches to a stake being a Corner of The 5^d Herregers Land Thence by the Same Two hundred ~~Twenty~~ and Seven pe^aches to a Stake being another Corner of ye 5^d Land. Thence by ye Lands of ~~Albertus~~ ^{Hans} Bower and Albertus Englehart South West Two hundred Twenty and Seven perches to the place of beginning. Containing five hundred Acres of land with Allowance of Six ⁰ Cent.

Surveyed March the 18th 17¹⁹/₂₀.
