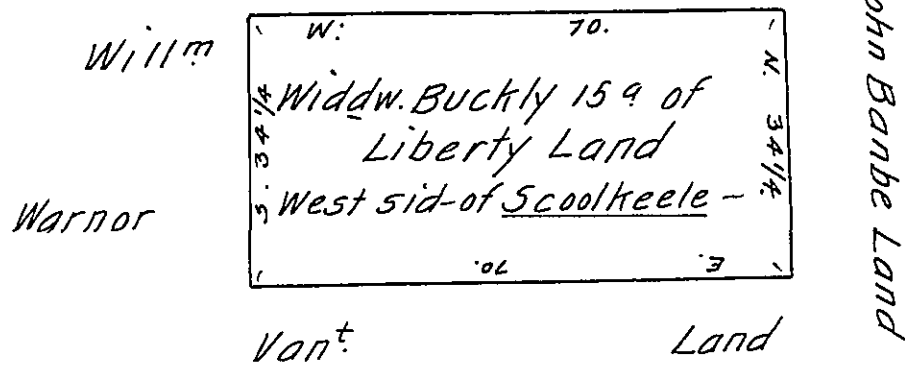


John Tho:in Right of Morris Liealin
