

By Vertue of a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the Seal of the province dated the 30th day of the 4^{mo} 1702. Granting unto John Baldwin an hundred acres of head-Land to be laid out unto him in the Township appropriated to Servants or elsewhere in the province fifty- thereof in Right of his own service to Joshua Hastings and fifty- in Right of his wife Katherine, serv^t to Isaac Blunston.

Survey'd unto Jn.^o Baldwin one hundred acres of Land. Scituate on the north side of the Northern Branch of Brandiwine Creek, beginning at a hickery at the Corner of James Wallis his land. Then by the said land South 277 perches to a Corner post, from thence by Vacant Land East 60 perches to a post. Thence by Vacant land and Peter Taylor's land North 235 perches to hickery tree. Then by Peter Taylor's land North 24 degr^s. west 46 perches again by the said Taylor's Land west 41 perches to the place of beginning. Survey'd by Isaac Taylor 7th 9^{br} 1702.
