That We would grant him a Resurvey in three several parcels of Land laid out in the Said Township by Vertue of Several Warr<sup>ts</sup> <sup>Granted</sup> for taking up the same. One to Eliz abeth Prichard for taking up two hundred and fifty Acres, One to John Prichard for two hundred Acres and the remainder purchased of William Howel for One hundred sixty eight Acres and a half. which three parcels should have contained Six hundred and eighteen Acres and a half. (thirty four Acres whereof are situate in Haverford Town) but have been laid out short of the quantities mentioned in the 5<sup>d</sup> Warr<sup>ts</sup>. These therefore are to require thee to resurvey to the s<sup>d</sup> Jn<sup>o</sup> Bevan the s<sup>d</sup> Several Tracts or parcels of Land in the Said Township. according to the Lines and Limits by which they are now bounded. and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>ia</sup> where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of ye Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the sixth of the 2<sup>d</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1702.
