These are to Authorize and Re-quire You or One of You to Survey and lay out to the 5^d John Budd the said quantity of Six hundred and twenty five Acres of Land in the County of Chester, or borders thereof within this Governm^t that has not been already survey'd nor taken up nor is concealed, nor seated by the Indians. (according to the Method of Townships appointed) and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} 23^d of the 12th Moth 1702.
