These are Therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and Require thee forthwith to Survey or Cause to be Survey'd unto him ye said Number of acres in ye afore said County where not already taken up, according to ye Method of Townshipps appoynted by ye Gover<sup>r</sup>. he settling and Improving the Same within Six Months after ye Date of Survey and make Returne here of to ye Secretarys Office.
