At ye Request of W^m Brainton in right of Joseph Allibane, y^t we would grant him to take up Two hundred & fifty acres of Land w^{ch} he bought of ye sd Joseph Allibone. Purchaser of five hundred acres. These are therefore to will & require thee in ye Proprietary's Name to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye County of Chester, where not already taken up, according to ye Method of Townships appointed by ye Govern^{rs} he seating & improveing ye same within Six Months from ye date of Survey, and make returns thereof into ye Govern^{rs} Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 16th Mo^o 1684.
