At ye Request of Samuel Buckley, Purchaser. y^t I would grant him to take up in part Three hundred Acres of Land in ye County of Philadelphia ^{or others} & a Lott in ye City ^{& Liberties} proportionable to his Purchase. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye aforemention'd County where not already taken up. he seating & improving ye same wth in one Year after ye Date of ye Survey. Also a Lott in any of ye streets sett out for Purchasers of his Quantity, he fencing it in & building upon ye same wth in six Months from ye Date of Survey & make Returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 25th 5th mo. 1684.
