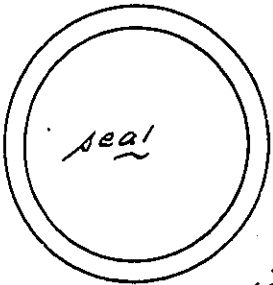

five hundred Acres of Land remaining yet due to them, two hundred and
fifty thereof being the Remainder untaken up of Hen. Baily's Purchase
of 1500 Acres and the other 250 Acres, the remainder untaken up of 750
Acres purchased by the s^d Thomas Musgrove of y^e Prop^{rs}. These are to
require thee to survey & lay out in y^e County of Philad^{ia} according to y^e
Method of Townships appointed to the s^d Hannah Price ~~the~~ ~~of~~ for
the uses afores^d the s^d number of five Hundred Acres of Land where
not already surrey'd nor taken up nor concealed nor seated by the Indians and
make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warrt. is to
remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by y^e Secretary. Given under
