



Surveyed unto Thomas Phillips a tract of land beginning at a corner tree being the corner tree of John Tathams land, thence running by the line of the aforesd Tathams land North West 340 pole to a corner marked post standing in the line of John Cluses land, thence along the sd line South West 240 pole to a corner marked tree thence along the pertition line of the two Counties South East 340 pole to a corner marked tree, thence North East by some Vacant land 240 pole to the first mentioned corner tree containing with allowances for roads 500 acres, per me
