And make returns into ye<sup>s</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>ia</sup> Where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain & a Copy thereof to be Deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee certified by ye<sup>s</sup> Secretary.
