



By virtue of a Warrant from Jacob Taylor Surv^r: Gen^l: to me directed bearing date the 5th day of the 4th month 1707; Pursuant to a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs}: of Property dated the 8th day of the first month 170⁹ to lay out unto John Rowland 500 acres in the County of Bucks; Surveyed & Laid out unto the s^d John Rowland a Tract of Land in Hilton township in the s^d County. Beginning at a small Ash tree in Cott: Mildmay's Line being also Thomas Cam's Corner, from thence by the s^d Cam's Line North West three hundred & twenty perches to a Hickory tree, Then North East by vacant Land two hundred & fifty pches to a small Hickory, Then by vacant Land South East three hundred & twenty perches to a Post between a small white oak & a black oak sapling, Then by the s^d Mildmay's line South West two hundred & fifty perches to the beginning. Containing five hundred acres Laid out the fifteenth day of the eighth month 1709.
