much as may be necessary & convenient to his Mill, near Samuel Burdens
Island, in pt of his late Purchase & his Brothers of four hundred Acres:
These are to will & require thee forthwth to resurvey or cause Resurvey to
be made of ye sd Land and make returns thereof into my Secretary's
office. Given at Philadelphia ye 2st of ye 5th mo 1684*
