



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 11th / 1703 to lay out unto Elizabethth Sands Relict of William Norcross the quantity of 500 acres in right of Leonard Fell Original Purchaser of the 5^d quantity, Laid out to the 5^d Elizabeth (for the use of herself and children mentioned in the Last Will & Testament of the 5^d William Norcross) a Tract of Land in Plumstead township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post by a Road four pole from Francis Plumsted's line at a Corner of Widow Musgreave's Land, Thence North West four pole distant from 5^d Plumsted's line three hundred and eleven perches and an halfe to a Post, Then by Joseph Paul's Land North East two hundred fifty seven perch to a Post, Then by Vacant Land South East 311 1/2 perches to a Post in the 5^d Musgreave's line, Then by the same South West 257 perches to the place of beginning Containeing five hundred acres and fifty five perches, Surveyed & Laid out the twelfth day of the fourth month 1704
