



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 30th of the 9th month 1702 to lay out unto Joseph Pike 1000 acres of Land in the County of Bucks in right of his purchase of 5000 acres under Samuel Rolls original purchaser of the 5^d quantity; Surveyed and laid out unto the 5^d Joseph Pike a tract of Land in Soulberry township in the 5^d County Beginning at a black oak by the River Delaware at Robert Heath's Corner, Thence four hundred ninety two perches to a Post three pole West from a Hickery marked FP, Then by Tobias Dymock's land North four degrees West two hundred and twelve perches to a Post by a black oak marked FP, Then by Randall Speakman's land East four hundred fifty nine perches to a small white oak by the 5^d River, Then down the several courses thereof to the place of beginning Containing 624 acres laid out the 5th day of the 3^d month 1705
