



In pursuance of an order from Jacob Taylor Sur: General dated the first 12<sup>th</sup> month 1729 for ye surveying unto William Tidmarsh of ye City of phyla: 246 acres of Land In the Right of Jeremiah Warrens Original purchase of — June 2<sup>d</sup> 1729 Surveyed and Set out to William Tidmarsh affor said This following Tract as followeth Beginning at a white oak Tree being late a corner of Morris Morris Land now John Lesters Thence by the line of ye said Lesters Land south 240 perches to a post Thence by a line of marked Trees West 160 perches to a small white oak Thence by the line of Jos: Crowdans Land North 260 perches to a white oak Thence by a line of marked trees East 160 perches to a small white oak Thence South 20 perches to the first mentioned place of Beginning Containing 246 acres with allowance at 6 pr Cent
