already taken up, he seating & improving ye same w<sup>m</sup>th in six Months from ye  
Date of Survey according to Regulation, & make Returns thereof into ye  
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia, y<sup>e</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1684
