

The Courses of Folkert Vandegrift's Land

Begining at a Corner — upon Delaware River, thence
North Nine Degrees Westerly — 123 Perches to a Corner
North 81° Easterly - - - - - 19 P. to a Corner
North 9° Westerly ————— 229 P. to a Small White oak
Stand? by a small run of water
North 27° West ————— 87 Rods to a stake
North 5° East ————— 30 to a White oak
West South West 2 1/2 Southerly - 37 Rods to a Black oak standing
by Poquessin
Thence down the several Courses of ye 5^d Rivolet Poquessin to ye mouth of ye afore-
mentioned small run of water where it empty's itself into ye 5^d Rivolet Poquessin.
Thence up the several Courses of ye 5^d small run of water to ye Easterly Corner of
ffrederick Vandegrift's Land standing by ye 5^d Run Side. Thence by ye 5^d ffredericks Land
South 18° easterly and 45 minutes 390 Perches to ye River Delaware. Thence by ye Courses of the
River 15 1/2 Perches to Begining Containing & Laid out for 215 acres.
