



By vertue of a warrant from Edward Pennington Surveyor General bearing date ye 17 of ye 6 m<sup>o</sup> 1700 directed unto me Requiring a Returne from me in persuance of a Verball order Received by me from the propriatory and Governour in or about the 2<sup>d</sup> m<sup>o</sup> 1683: Comanding me to Lay out a Certaine Quantity of Land in a Certaine place by the River Delaware above the falls in the County of Bucks the w<sup>ch</sup> Land was intended as Apperes to be part of two thousand acres of Land Purchased by Richard Vickris of Bristol I do hereby Certiefy into his office that fourth with in persuance of the said order that I have Surveyd and Laid out a Certaine tract of Land in the place apointed as afores<sup>d</sup> begining at a Corner deviding it from Thomas Janies Land by Delaware River above the falls afores<sup>d</sup> from thence west south west sixty seven perches thence west by the said Janies Land Eight hundred and foure perches then north by ye said Land ninty six perches to a corner in the Line of Samuel Overtons Land from thence by the same Land East seven hundred sixty foure perches to ye said River from thence by the River on e<sup>s. 54<sup>d</sup> E</sup> hundred and twere perches to the place of begining Containeing and Laid out for: foure hundred and eighty <sup>three</sup> acres: P<sup>r</sup>.
