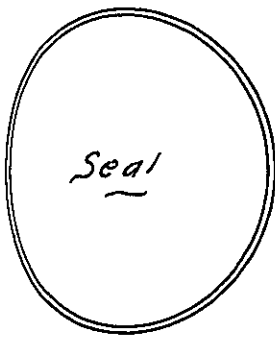

At the Request of George Willard of the County of Bucks That we would Grant him a Resurvey on two several parcels of Land in the s^d County the one laid out for two hundred and forty six Acres to Joseph Paul in right of Edw^d Blenman, the other granted for One hundred Acres to Thomas Rowland but are now both in the s^d George's possession: These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the s^d parcels in one Tract (if it may be) according to the first Lines and true bounds of Survey and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 11th of the 6th month 1702.
