



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 5th ~~1700~~¹⁷⁰² to Resurvey all the Tracts or parcels of land within the County of Bucks which may reasonably be suspected to have been unduely surveyed when first taken up, and have not yet been rectified Resurveyed unto Henry Paxson a Tract of Land in Newtown in Bucks County Beginning at a Post in Ezra Croasdale's line, Thence by the sd Croasdale's land North seventeen degrees West three hundred and forty perches to a Post, Then by the said Croasdale's land East twenty one degrees South Eighty two perches and an halfe to a Post, Then by Israel Morris land South fourteen degrees East two hundred eighty eight perches to a black oak, then by the same Morris land South seventy four degrees West fifty perches to the place of beginning Containeing one hundred and fourteen Acres' Resurveyed the twenty eighth day of the third month 1703.
