



According to a warrant to me directed by Edward Penington Surveyor General bearing date the 17th day of the 3rd month last past surveyed unto William Cooper one Tract of Land in the right of Christopher Atkison Lying in the County of Bucks Beginning at a small chesnut being a corner of ~~Thomas Parsons~~ Margrit Atkisons Land & standing in Thomas Parsons Line Thence north west one hundred eighty four perches and a half by the said Parsons & other Land vacant to a post Thence by vacant Land south west 434 perches to a black oak being another corner of Margrit Atkisons Land & thence south east by vacant Land 184 1/2 perches to a black oak being another corner of the said Atkisons Land Thence by the said Atkisons Land north east 434 perches to the first station containing five hundred acres the 25th day of the 6th mo 1700 P.
