



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Com^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 5th ^{11th} 1702 to Resurvey all such tracts or parcels of land within the County of Bucks as may be reasonably suspected to have been unduly surveyed when first taken up and have not yet been rectified; Resurveyed unto George Pownal a tract of land in Soulberry township in Bucks County. Beginning at a dead black oak at Randal Speakman's Corner, Thence by the s^d Speakman's line West five hundred sixty three perches to a black oak, Then by the s^d Speakman's land North one hundred sixty four perches to a black oak, Then by Basillean Foster's land East four hundred perches to a black oak, Then by the same North East by East one hundred thirty two perches to a white oak by the said River, Then down the several courses thereof to the place of beginning Containing five hundred and fifty acres Resurveyed the 1st day of the 5th month 1703
