acres desired be within one mile of Delaware River.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and Require the forthwith
to survey or Cause to be surveyd unto him the said number of acres in ye afore
said County where not already taken up according to the Method of Towne-
shipp appointed by ye Gover^r he seating and Improveing the same within
six months after ye Date of survey and make Returne here off to ye Secre-
tarys Office. Dated at Philadelphia ye 30th of ye 9th month 1686
