These are in ye Proprietarys Name to will & require thee forth w<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye s<sup>d</sup> Number of Acres in ye afore mentioned County where not already taken up, he seating & improving the same w<sup>th</sup> in six Months from ye Date of Survey, & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia, the 29<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684
