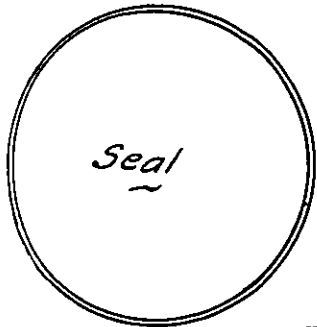

At the Request of Henry Child Original Purchaser of One thousand Acres of Land in this Province That We would grant him to take up five hundred Acres thereof in one Tract: These are to Authorise and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the said Henry Child according to the Method of Townships as conveniently as may be the said number of five hundred Acres in the County of Bucks in one Tract where not already survey'd nor taken up nor concealed nor seated by the Indians: And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 14th of the 4th Month 1703
