



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commrs. of Property bearing date the 10th. day of the 9th. month 1718. Surveyed and laid out unto Jane Lundy [wife of Richard Lundy formerly Jane Lyon] a tract of Land upon Delaware River above Tohickan in Buck's County Beginning at an Ash tree by the sd. River, Delaware. from thence, extending west by vacant Land sixteen perches to a black oak tree. Then North one hundred & ninety perches to a black oak in John Streper's Line. Then by vacant Land East seventy Eight perches to a Hickory tree by the sd. River. Then down the sd. River by the several Courses thereof to the place of beginning Containing fifty acres, surveyed the 20th. day of the 10th. month 1718. Certified under my hand.
