



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries Commⁿ to me directed
 bearing date the 30th day of the 4th month 1702. Resurveyed
 unto John Large a Tract of Land in Buckingham Township in the
 County of Bucks. Beginning at a Post by a small white oak at
 Richard Lundy's Corner. Thence by the said Lundy's, Burgess &
 Smyth's land S.W. 336 perches to a black oak sapling, Then by
 vacant - N.W. 51 perches to a heap of stones by a white oak sap-
 ling. Then by William Say's land N.E. 336 perches to a Post in James
 Streater's line. Then by the said Streater's land S.E. 51 perches to
 the beginning Containing 107 Acres and 16 perches.

Resurveyed the 8th day of the 8th month 1702.
