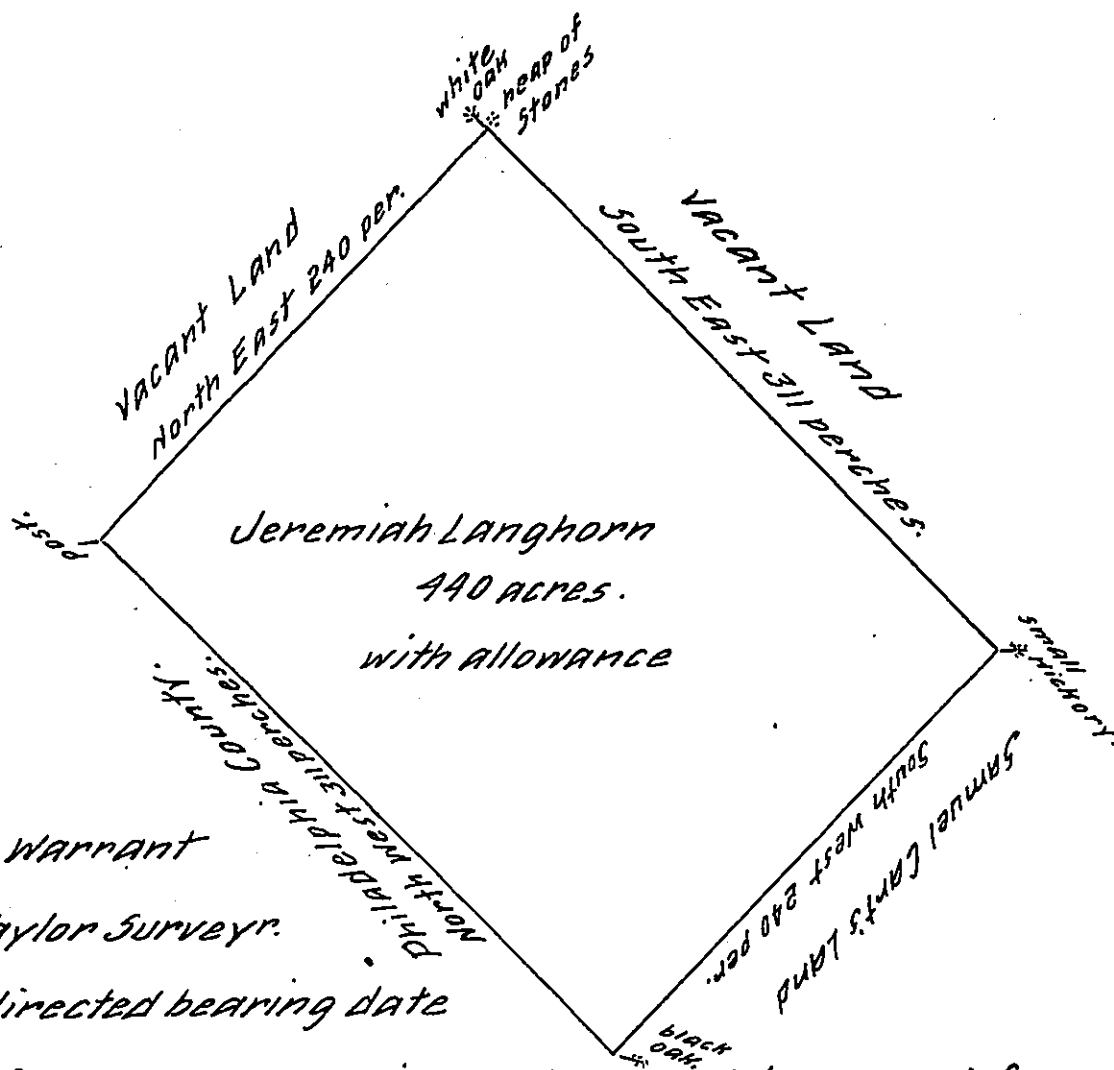

Gen^l. to me directed bearing date

the 16th. day of August Anno Domini. 1719 Pursuant to a Warrant from the
Commrs. of Property bearing date the 13th. of the same month. To
Survey & lay out unto Jeremiah Langhorn four hundred and forty
acres in the County of Bucks in right of John Brock's purchase
of one thousand acres, Surveyed unto the sd. Jeremiah Langhorn
a tract of Land in Hilton township in the sd. County. Beginning at
a Black Oak in the County Line at Samuel Cart's Corner, from
thence running North West by the sd. County, ^{Line} three hundred &
Eleven perches to a Post. Then by vacant Land North East two
hundred and forty perches to a heap of Stones, Then South
East by vacant Land three hundred & eleven perches to a
small Hickory. Then by the sd. Samuel Cart's Land South West
two hundred & forty perches to the place of beginning.
Containing four hundred & forty Acres with allowance at 6 p
Cent. Laid out the 18th day of August Anno Domini. 1719.
