

I do hereby Certifie That there is Delivered into the General Survs. office the Return of the Resurvey of a parcel of Land Resurveyd. to Joseph Growden the 27th. of the first month 1702 by John Cutler by vertue of a warrant under the hands of the Commiss^{rs}. of Property and the seal of the Province bearing date the 21st. day of the 11 Month 1701 which being examined and revised in the said office is as follows viz

The said Tract being Called Bensalem. Scituate in the County of Bucks. beginneth at a Pine tree by the River Delaware being the Corner of Walter fforrest's Land from thence extending North North West by the fforrest's and John Gilbert's land three hundred and eight perches to a Corner Spanish oak by Poetquessink Creek Then up the Several Courses of the said Creek five hundred eighty eight perches to a post at Joseph Hirl's Corner Thence South South east by the said Hirl's Land six hundred and eighteen perches to a Corner black oak by the said Delaware River thence down the several Courses of the said River four hundred. Seventy three perches to the place of beginning Containing one thousand two hundred and seven acres.
