These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey to the Said Joseph Growdon ~~the same~~ according to the Method of Townships the Said quantity of One thousand Acres of Land where not already taken up in this Province, nor has been Survey'd nor Concealed nor is Seated by the Indians. And make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadia. where this Warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd. to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadia. the 8<sup>th</sup>. day of the 4<sup>th</sup>. Mo<sup>th</sup>. 1703.
