



By virtue of a General Warrant from the Commrs. of Property to me directed bearing date the 5th ^{11th}/_{mo}. 1702 to Resurvey All such Tracts or parcels of land within the County of Bucks as may reasonably be suspected to have been unduely surveyed when first taken up, and have not yet been rectified, Resurveyed unto Henry Marjorum a Tract of Land in Makefield Township in the sd. County formerly Laid out to John Luff, Beginning at a Stone at Potato Creeks mouth. being also Joseph Wood's Corner. Thence by the sd Wood's line S.W. by W. 318 perches to a Stone, Then S. 75 degrs. W. 59 per. to a white oak. Then S. 90 degrs E. 32 p. to a Maple at Jeofrey Hawkins Corner, Then by the sd. Hawkins Land West 528 p. to a white oak. Then by Richard Hough's Land N. 2 degrs. W. 56. per. to a heap of Stones in John Parsons line. Then by the sd. Parsons Land East 464 per. to a Post. Then N. 75 degrs. E. 90 per. to a Red oak. Then N. 59 degrs. E. 305. per. to a Post by the River, Then down the same S. 93. E. 52. pr. to the beginning. Containing 218 acres Resurveyed the 15th ^{11th}/_{mo}. 1702.
